Piecekeeper Project Bag Class

We will be making this free pattern, but you will have to purchase (\$0) and print the pattern so it will be in your account, along with access to video that will be available for you anytime

Supply List - (also listed in pattern)

- * Quilt Main fabric / Lining each cut 13" x 18"-quilted together for front/ back of bag
- * Cut Coordinating fabric for Binding -18" square (Note: large than pattern states)
- * Cut Coordinating fabric for Handle (4" x 12")
- * Cut Coordinating fabric for Bottom border front of bag (3" x 17)
- * 8" x 17" Mesh
- * 4" x 12" med wt. (SF11) interfacing for handle
- * 3" x 17" med wt. (SF 101) interfacing for border

Thread that matches binding and zipper tape color

Flower Head Pins (fine quilting pins will not work when making bags)

Wonder Clips necessary (used when sewing zipper to mesh)

1/4" foot and zipper foot for sewing machine

Zipper – 24" handbag zipper

Soft and Stable (also known as Bosal R-Form) is a foam that will give your bag stability. Can be purchased here: ByAnnie's Soft and Stable

Prior to class:

- 1. Quilt main fabric and lining together prior to class (watch free video to see how)
- 2. Cut other pieces as noted above. We will cut your quilted piece to size in class
