SUPPLY LIST FOR QUICK - NO CORNERS - TABLE RUNNER

- 7 5" SQUARES will be background border fabric
- 6 5" SQUARES the top, middle & bottom squares
- 4 5" SQUARES Focus fabric even fussy cut would work
- 4 5" SQUARES for alternate blocks

Total of 21 5" squares. Backing fabric and binding. Finished size is approximately 15" x 34".

- Ruler
- Cutting matt
- Rotary cutter
- Marking tool
- □ Iron





Check out the new updated ruler list. We have 77 rulers from the large 20" Dresdens to tiny templates for tiny quilts. We have several Flying geese rulers in different sizes. Need to cut scallops? There is a ruler for that. Take a peek at the Updated Missouri Star Block books and grab a new ruler to make something beautiful.

Need help cutting binding? We have Accquilt dies to cut 1.5, 2.5 and 3.5 dies to cut accurate strips. Doing a rag quilt? There is a die for that. Cut up to (6) 8.5" squares at a time, rag cuts included. Don't have a cutter? We do have 1 hand die cutter to lend out.
